Matters arising

Key points were taken from the previous meeting:

Principals update

On the 27th July, D.E.S. published a roadmap for the Return to School.

Overriding objective is to keep all staff and students safe. To keep the virus out of the school and to contain a spread should it occur. All school practices in classroom, corridors need be looked at. Anything that is not essential that compromises safety must be set to one side.

Present

- The school have been given extra resources such as extra cleaners, an extra caretaker, more teachers, and more money.
- The last two weeks the school have spent time hiring resources.
- The timetables must be redone to make them Covid-19 friendly.
- The school are working on a plan to return to school which will be ready for the 20th August.
- Consultation on the plan will be with the Parents (now), Staff (11.30 am tomorrow) and Students on Monday 17th August followed by Board of Management approval.
